Presentation of the workshops

Context and objective of the workshops

Within the framework of the **European Network in D-Flexible Teaching (ENID-Teach)** project and with the aim of broadening the impact of the training programme, five workshops have been designed as a practical complement to the courses previously delivered. These workshops aim not only to consolidate the learning acquired, but also to reach a wider audience, including university teachers and those interested in further training.

The main purpose of the workshops is to provide teachers with effective and applicable tools in their teaching practice. To this end, a direct and agile format has been adopted, consisting of synchronous sessions of short duration, which facilitates the active participation of the participants.

Approach and format

The workshops are characterised by their practical approach, focused on offering applicable solutions to the challenges of teaching in digital environments. As they are synchronous sessions, they encourage direct and enriching interaction between the participants and the teaching team, guaranteeing a dynamic and participative training experience.

The workshops, conducted in Spanish with English subtitles, are implemented at the end of the NOOCs. They are addressed to teachers registered in our databases, either as participants in previous courses or as members of the *International Cooperation Network for Knowledge Transfer and Digital Learning (ReCoIn-TaD)*.

Topics covered in the workshops

Each workshop develops one of the methodologies explored in the project's courses, with the aim of deepening its practical application:

1. Connected and critical methodologies.
2. Collaborative and research methodologies.
3. Active and gamified methodologies.
4. Hybrid or mixed methodologies.
5. Programme design for flexible learning.

Characteristics of the workshops

- **Teaching staff:**

The workshops are taught by a team of professors and researchers from the **Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia (UNED)**, who contribute their academic and

practical experience to guarantee high quality and relevant training.
